The upcoming activity will be a tour of the Troegs Brewery. The tour will be approximately 2 hours, which will consist of a 45 minute walking tour of the facility and the rest of the time will be spent sampling the Troegs products. The brewery is located in Harrisburg at [800 Paxton St.](#)

Founded in 1996 the small family owned brewery is dedicated to hand crafting specialty beers. Chris and John Troegner have been working hard to get Central Pennsylvania on the brewing map. Since 1997, these Mechanicsburg natives have been handcrafting world-class beers that combine traditional English brewing techniques with the eclecticism of new American brewing. But how they reached this point is as compelling as where they are headed.

Today, the brewery produces seven different beers including Hopback Amber Ale, Troegenator, Doublebock, Rugged Trail Nut Brown Ale, Tröegs Pale Ale, Oatmeal Stout (seasonal), Sunshine Pils (seasonal), and The Mad Elf (seasonal), and distributes its product in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Maryland, Delaware and Virginia.

Tröegs is a family nickname, from the founders surname Troegner. Combined with a Flemish word "Kroeg", which means pub, we get Tröegs.

Tröegs Brewery is located just off the 2nd St./ Capital Exit on Rte. 83. At the first stop light make a right onto Paxton St., proceed over the bridge and Troegs entrance is on the left hand side (before the Ford Dealership).

**From Pennsylvania Turnpike:** Exit 18, 83 North towards Harrisburg. Go over the Susquehanna River and take the first exit, 2nd St. Capital Exit. At the first stop light make a right onto Paxton St. Proceed over the bridge and Troegs entrance is on the left hand side (before the Ford Dealership).

**From North Interstate 81:** Take the Harrisburg/ York 83 South Split. Follow signs for Harrisburg on 83 South. Take the 2nd St./ Capital Exit. At the first stop light make a right onto Paxton St. Proceed over the bridge and Troegs entrance is on the left hand side (before the Ford Dealership).

**From South Interstate 81:** Take 581 North/ East, Harrisburg/ York Split. Go over the Susquehanna River and take the first exit, 2nd St. Capital Exit. At the first stop light make a right onto Paxton St. Proceed over the bridge and Troegs entrance is on the left hand side (before the Ford Dealership).

**From 83:** 83 North towards Harrisburg. Go over the Susquehanna River and take the first exit, 2nd St. Capital Exit. At the first stop light make a right onto Paxton St. Proceed over the bridge and Troegs entrance is on the left hand side (before the Ford Dealership).
